

# PROJECT open [ "Pure Make"

## Sourcing Options Overview

- "Pure Make" (100% in-house)
- "Make" with external **consultants**
- "Make" with **subcontracted** functions
- "Make", followed by **spin-off**
- "Buy" from provider and customize in-house
- "Buy" from provider, with financial **investment** in provider
- "Buy" from provider, but "nurture" provider with **partnership** and long-term contract
- "Pure Buy" (100% external)



# PROJECT Open

## OSS Business Model

- Little Sales, just ↑ marketing & PR
    - Sales is usually 50% of IT company costs...
  - Reuse of Software ↑ from other OSS-Projects
    - Saves 50%- 80% of development costs
- 4x - 10x better value for Customers  
← 50% (free software)  
→ Still 2x - 5x value to be distributed



Open-Source "Dissonance

- Company Size:  
Usually smaller than closed-source
- No "pushy" Sales Organization
- New possibilities for customer:  
May cause fear
- Open-Source FUD:  
Incomprehension of Biz model, patents, ...
- Profile of the people in the OSS-Companies:  
Dominated by Techies



## Project Self Diagnosis




